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His research contributions deal with the issues of payment systems risk, contagion and the lender of last resort and the He is well known for his research work in the banking area, that has been published in the main journals in the field, as well as for his book *Microeconomics of banking* (MIT Press, 1997, 2007 second edition), co-authored with Jean-Charles Rochet.

He has been a consultant for the European Investment Bank, the New York Fed, the European Central Bank, the World Bank, the Interamerican Development Bank, MEFF and the European Investment Bank. He was consultant for the European Central Bank for its research network on Macroprudential regulation (MARS) until 2012.
