



BEN S. BERNANKE

Chairman of the Board of Governors, US Federal Reserve System

Ben S. Bernanke began a second term as Chairman of the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System on February 1, 2010. Dr. Bernanke also serves as Chairman of the Federal Open Market Committee, the System's principal monetary policymaking body. He originally took office as Chairman on February 1, 2006, when he also began a 14-year term as a member of the Board. His second term as Chairman ends January 31, 2014, and his term as a Board member ends January 31, 2020.

Chairman Bernanke previously served as: Chairman of the President's Council of Economic Advisers (June 2005-January 2006); member of the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System (2002-2005); and Chair of the Economics Department at Princeton University (1996-2002).

Chairman Bernanke received a B.A. in economics from Harvard University and a Ph.D. in economics from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology.
